A program system of early intervention services for young children with developmental delays and disabilities- and their families through an Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP).



SERVICES OFFERED

Special instruction, occupational therapy, physical therapy, speech pathology/audiology, case management services, health, and adaptive services to help enable the child and family to functionally participate in daily activities, family education and support, and connections to available community resources and support agencies to best meet child and family needs.

ELIGIBILITY

Every child, birth until age three, is eligible for screening and evaluation to identify possible health, functional, developmental, and educational needs in the following areas: cognitive, communication, social-emotional, fine/gross motor, hearing, speech, vision, adaptive self-help.
