Qualified applicants MUST meet the following criteria:

- Maryland resident who is a 2023 high school graduate.
- Have a 3.0 GPA or higher.
- Committed to attending a two-year or four-year college, university or technical school during the 2023-2024 school season with an intent to pursue a degree in one of the STEAM fields.
- Demonstrate participation in a model railroad youth activity program such as Youth in Model Railroading[®], Scouts MRR program, 4H model railroading, MRR Youth clinics, active participant in building a home layout, or belong to an organized model railroad club.
- Write and submit an essay of 300 words or less describing how their involvement in model railroading as a
 hobby has impacted their lives and benefited their education within one or more of the STEAM areas of
 interest.
- Include one reference that can attest to their involvement in model railroading activities. (RMRS will be contacting any listed references, so please let them know ahead of time.
